C. MMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY BEFORE THE UTILITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

TARIFF FILING OF NORTH SHELBY WATER COMPANY INCREASING SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGE AND CASE NO. 7914 RECONNECTION CHARGE AND INSTITUTING A DISCONNECT CHARGE

ORDER

On June 23, 1980, North Shelby Water Company filed revised tariff sheets, to be effective July 15, 1980, whereby it proposes to increase the service connection fee and reconnection charge and to institute a disconnect charge.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that an investigation will be necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed charges and that such investigation cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed charges be and they are hereby suspended and the application of the charges is deferred for a period of five (5) months on and after July 15, 1980.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further orders in this matter in the event the proceedings in this case shall be terminated by final order and/or otherwise prior to the expiration of the five (5) month suspension.
