ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on the 26th day of November, 1980, at 1:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's Offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Foothills Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation shall at least twenty days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of the hearing. Alternatively, the Corporation shall publish once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by the Corporation a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges as set forth in the Application. Said notice shall include the following language:

> The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Foothills Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation. However, the Utility Regulatory Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those included in this notice.
