O R D E R

On September 11, 1980, South Central Bell Telephone Company made a tariff filing with the Commission, wherein it proposed to obsolete Two-Tier Payment Plan rates, rules and regulations governing Dimension PBX Service. In addition, South Central Bell proposed to establish Variable Term Payment Plan rates, rules and regulations governing Dimension PBX Service.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the tariff filing, and that such investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the tariff filing be and it hereby is suspended for a period of five (5) months, from the proposed effective date of October 1, 1980. The pages of the tariff filing hereby suspended are:


