O R D E R

On December 3, 1980, Louisville 2-Way Radio Service, Inc., filed with the Utility Regulatory Commission a revised tariff sheet, whereby it proposes to reduce the rental rates for tone-only and tone-plus-voice selective calling pocket receivers, to be effective December 23, 1980.

Having reviewed the tariff and being sufficiently advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the proposed reduction in rates is fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff filing, reducing the rental rate for tone-only selective calling pocket receivers from \$9.75 per month per unit to \$5.25 per month per unit, and for tone-plus-voice selective calling pocket receivers from \$11.50 per month per unit to \$8.50 per month per unit, be and it is hereby approved. The tariff sheet herein approved is Second Revised Sheet No. 11.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Louisville 2-Way Radio, Inc., shall provide notice of the new rates in the manner prescribed by 807 KAR 25:030, Sections 5 and 7, and shall file with the Commission proof of such notice within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other rates and charges not specifically referred to herein shall remain the same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Louisville 2-Way Radio, Inc., shall file with the Commission appropriate tariff sheets as approved herein, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
