O R D E R

On December 8, 1981, Kentucky CATV Association filed a motion for prehearing conference, and on December 11, 1981, South Central Bell responded.

The Commission, having considered the motions and the record, and being advised, declares that a prehearing conference should be held in this matter on January 7, 1981, at 1:30 p.m., for the following purposes:

- (1) To enumerate the issues to be resolved by the Commission,
- (2) To establish which issues might be submitted on briefs, and
- (3) To determine the order of testimony and cross-examination concerning the appropriate formula or methodology for computing pole attachment rates.

It is understood that the question of the Commission's jurisdiction over the rates, terms and conditions of CATV pole attachments is not in issue in this proceeding.

After such conference, any party may file additional testimony to that which was prefiled on January 4, 1982, within such time as the Commission may designate.
