O R D E R

On March 20, 1981 Kentuckiana Burglar and Fire Alarm Association, Inc., by counsel, filed its Motion requesting that the Commission remand the hearing scheduled April 1, 1981 and consolidate the above case with Case No. 8150 (Notice of South Central Bell Telephone Company of an adjustment in its intrastate rates and charges).

On March 25, 1981 South Central Bell Telephone Company filed its Response to the Motion wherein it opposes the consolidation.

The Commission, having considered the Motion, Response and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the complaint herein should not be consolidated with South Central Bell's current general rate increase filing (Case No. 8150), since the complaint concerns tariffed rates and charges which were made effective November 10, 1980, and which are not the subject of Case No. 8150 except to the extent that any additional increases are proposed in that case and, that the Motion should be overruled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion of Kentuckiana Burglar  
and Fire Alarm Association, Inc. be and it hereby is overruled.
