O R D E R

On December 1, 1980, Evergreen Sewage Disposal Co., Inc. ("Applicant") filed with the Public Service Commission, formerly the Utility Regulatory Commission, its application seeking authority to increase the rate charged its customers for sewage service. On May 5, 1981, the Commission issued its Order granting the proposed increase. Thereafter, on May 22, 1981, the Applicant filed a petition for rehearing stating that the Commission in its Order of May 5, 1981, did not deal with the issue of an assessment levied by the utility against its stockholders.

The matter of the assessment of stockholders was not dealt with in the Commission's Order of May 5, 1981, as it is a matter between the Applicant and its stockholders and is outside the authority granted the Commission by Chapter 278 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. The Commission, after consideration of the petition, all evidence of record and being advised, reaffirms its original position on the matter and further finds the petition for rehearing should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petition for rehearing filed by the Applicant on May 22, 1981, be and it is hereby denied.
