O R D E R

The Fox Creek Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Fox Creek), by letter received on November 25, 1980, requested permission to transfer its meter test records and historical data from a card file to an on-line computer information storage and retrieval system. This request for authority to deviate from Regulation 807 KAR 50:05, Section 15(2)(a) is made in compliance with Regulation 807 KAR 50:015, Section 24. The Commission, by Order dated December 5, 1980 requested some additional information and this was supplied by Fox Creek on December 11, 1980.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being advised is of the opinion and Finds:

1) That the meter test information and historical data required by Regulation 807 KAR 50:05, Section 15 will be maintained in the computer storage system.

2) That adequate provisions for data storage, protection of stored data and retrieval of information from the computer storage have been made.

3) That the proposed system will improve the record keeping operations of Fox Creek and will therefore benefit both the Utility and its members.


THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application by Fox Creek for a deviation from the requirements of Regulation 807 KAR 50:015, Section 15(2)(a) is sustained and the meter test data and historical information may be transferred to and stored in an


on-line computer information storage and retrieval system.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Fox Creek shall prepare an annual print-out from the computer listing those meters which are due for a periodic test during the following year.
