O R D E R

On January 28, 1981, Warren County Water District (District), by counsel, filed its Motion requesting that the above case be advanced for purposes of hearing. In support of the Motion the District filed the Affidavit of Mr. Joe Liles, General Manager.

As grounds for the Motion, it is stated that the customers of the District will be adversely affected because of the increased expenses required by deficit financing at high interest rates until rate relief is granted. The Affidavit states, among other things, that on February 12, 1981 the wholesale water rates charged by the Bowling Green Municipal Utilities' Board will be increased.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and Affidavit and being advised, hereby ORDERS that said Motion be and it hereby is sustained.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on the 18th day of February, 1981, at 2:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Warren County Water District shall at least twenty days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing. Alternatively, the District shall publish once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by the District a notice setting forth

the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges as set forth in the Application. Said notice shall include the following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Warren County Water District. However, the Utility Regulatory Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those included in this notice.
