O R D E R

On the 3rd day of February, 1981, Cincinnati Bell, Inc. filed its Application seeking a certificate of convenience and necessity to bid on a telephone franchise from the City of Newport, Kentucky. Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.020(3) no utility may apply for a franchise from any governmental agency until it has obtained a certificate of convenience and necessity from the Commission based on a finding that there is a need and demand for the service sought to be rendered.

A hearing in this matter was held in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky on February 24, 1981.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that there is a need and demand for telephone service in the City of Newport, Kentucky. Since the Commission's authority in such matters is limited by statute to a determination as to whether there is a need and demand for the service, no finding or determination is made herein as to the validity of any of the provisions of the franchise

offered by the City or the manner in which any franchise fee is to be treated for rate purposes.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That Cincinnati Bell, Inc. be and it hereby is granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to bid on a telephone franchise in the City of Newport, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Cincinnati Bell, Inc., should it become the successful bidder, file with the Commission a copy of the franchise.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That this Order shall not be construed as granting a certificate of convenience and necessity to construct utility facilities in the City.
