On April 9, 1981, the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division filed a Motion for Extension of Time from April 9, 1981 to April 16, 1981 within which to submit its Requests for Information to South Central Bell Telephone Company (Company). The Motion states that the reason for the request is the voluminous nature of the Application (Notice) and Exhibits and the unusually short period for initial review.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the Application (Notice) and Exhibits of the Company were made available to the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division on or about the date of filing (February 20, 1981) and that, while the grounds in support of the Motion are therefore questionable, a brief extension should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion of the Attorney General's Consumer Intervention Division be and it hereby is sustained to the extent that the time by which the Attorney General

shall submit its Requests for Information to South Central Bell Telephone Company be and it hereby is extended to and including April 13, 1981.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the time by which South Central Bell Telephone Company shall file Responses to the Requests for Information be and it hereby is extended to and including April 27, 1981.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That all other provisions of the Commission's Order of Procedure entered March 31, 1981 shall remain in full force and effect.
