O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Woodlawn, Oakdale and Husbands Road Water District (Sewer System) shall file an original and five copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to the Attorney General's Division of Consumer Intervention by July 20, 1981. If neither the requested information nor a motion for extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case will be dismissed.

1. Provide a copy of the invoices for repair and maintenance work performed during the test year of over \$100 and state what the work was for.

2. To whom are the directors fees of \$2,700 paid and what are their duties?

3. A copy of your notification of increase in rent stating when it will become effective and the proposed amount of the rent.

4. Provide a depreciation schedule for the utility plant in service.

5. Provide a copy of the utility's electric bills for the test year showing the amount of KWH used, the current charge to the utility and the total amount of KWH purchased from each power source.

6. Provide an invoice for the insurance expense of \$2,025, describing what is covered by the policy and the amount of the premium.

7. If available, provide a breakdown of the revenues and expenses of the utility during the test year by month.
