## ORDER

The Commission, having been advised that Applicant failed to provide notice of the hearing scheduled July 9, 1981, at 1:00 p.m., as directed by the Commission, and Applicant, by letter received July 7, 1981, having waived the statutory suspension period until November 1, 1981, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that the hearing in the above case scheduled July 9, 1981, be and it hereby is rescheduled on August 5, 1981, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Applicant shall at least 20 days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a type-written or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of the hearing. Alternatively, the Applicant shall publish once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by the Applicant a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges as set forth in the Application, one of said notices to be published not more than 21 days or less than seven days prior to the hearing as required

by KRS 424.130. Said notice shall include the following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Montgomery County Water District Number One. However, the Public Service Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those rates included in this notice.
