O R D E R

On June 4, 1981, Western Kentucky Gas Company (Company), by counsel, filed its Motion for Extension of Time from June 10, 1981, to at least June 24, 1981, in which to file responses to requests for information by the Staff of the Commission set forth in the Commission's Order entered May 22, 1981.

In support of the motion, it is stated that the Order of Procedure of the Commission entered May 21, 1981, directed the Company to file responses to requests for information and supplemental requests for information by July 8, 1981, while the Order entered May 22, 1981, directed the Company to file responses to the Staff Requests by June 10, 1981. The motion also states that the Company has employed two additional personnel from Arthur Andersen & Company to work on the information requested and that it would be necessary to employ an additional accountant and that it would require the individual to work over the June 5, 1981, weekend in order to meet the deadline.

The Commission, having considered the motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the additional expense

of employing personnel to meet the June 10, 1981 date is not justified and that an extension of time until June 24, 1981, to file responses should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion for Extension of Time until June 24, 1981, to file responses to requests for information by the Staff be and it hereby is sustained.
