## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Salt River Water District shall file an original and five copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to the Attorney General's Division of Consumer Intervention by September 14, 1981. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case will be dismissed.

- 1. Provide a breakdown of the test year salary expenses including the number of employees, duties and responsibilities of each employee, the total hours worked in providing their duties and the total compensation of each. Also include details of the pro forma adjustment to this account.
- 2. A detailed breakdown or copies of monthly invoices of the following expenses for the test period ending May 31, 1981:

(a)	Power purchased for pumping	\$11,862
(b)	Chemicals	8,315
(c)	Repairs and maintenance	5,929
(d)	Office supplies and expenses	3,561
(e)	Insurance	2,536
(f)	Transportation	1,639
(g)	Operating supplies	1,148
(h)	Other	761

- 3. A detailed breakdown of legal and accounting expenses as to charges and services performed. A detailed analysis of the costs in this rate case should be provided. This breakdown should note the amounts paid in salaries, fees, retainers, and expenses of counsel, accountants, engineers, clerks, witnesses, or anyone involved in this case with detailed working papers supporting the analysis. At minimum the working papers should show the payee, dollar amount, reference (i.e., voucher no., etc.), account charged, hourly rates, and time charged to the utility according to each invoice, and a description of the service provided. This analysis of costs should also include office supplies and expenses, traveling expenses, and other expenses incurred directly in connection with this case.
- 4. Bad debts for the test year was \$956 and for the year ending May 31, 1980, was zero. How was the amount for bad debt estimated?
