## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That the above case be and it hereby is set for hearing on September 14, 1981, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That General Telephone Company of Kentucky shall at least 20 days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates or charges setting forth the place, date and hour of the hearing. Alternatively, the Company shall publish once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by the Company, a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates or charges as set forth in the Application, one of said notices to be published not more than 21 days or less than seven days prior to the hearing as required by KRS 424.130. Said notice shall include the following language:

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by General Telephone Company of Kentucky. However, the Public Service Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those rates included in this notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That General Telephone Company of Kentucky shall file on or before the date of hearing its testimony in verified prepared form and also file studies applicable to the proposed rates and charges.
