O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Rolling Fields, Inc., D/B/A Rolling Fields Sewage Treatment System shall file an original and five copies of the following information with the Commission by November 11, 1981. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case will be dismissed.

(1) Provide a breakdown of the taxes and licenses expense shown on Exhibit D.

(2) Please provide the names of the other sewer utilities you used as a basis for the following expenses and your determination as to why this should be the amount expensed.

- (a) bookkeeping fee
- (b) director's fee
- (c) bad debt expense
- (d) accounting fees
- (e) insurance costs
- (f) plant supplies
- (g) repairs on the plant

(3) Submit a list of the duties of the director.

(4) In item 9 of page 3 in your October 16, 1981, response you stated that the rent projected is estimated on the basis of the anticipated floor space to be used by the utility. Provide a detailed calculation of how the \$600/year rental expense was determined.

(5) Give a basis for your collection charge. If Mt. Washington Water Company performs this service, what will be their fee?

(6) Provide details of the assumptions used to determine the estimated electric usage including the total KWH consumed and the rates of the utility providing the service. Also submit the same information concerning water usage including the total gallons consumed and the rates of the water company.

(7) Provide an analysis of the total lots available for sale and the total lots sold to date.
