THE APPLICATION OF THE BRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 1, BROOKSVILLE, KENTUCKY, FOR (1) A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AUTHORIZING SAID DISTRICT TO CON-STRUCT MAJOR IMPROVEMENTS AND ADDITIONS TO ITS WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM, INCLUDING A NEW PUMPING STATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MAIN LINE, NEEDED TO SERVE WATER TO SAID DISTRICT PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 74 OF THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES; (2) SEEKING APPROVAL OF THE ADJUSTMENT OF WATER SERVICE RATES AND CHARGES; AND (3) SEEKING APPROVAL OF PROPOSED PLAN OF FINANCING SAID PROJECT

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That the above case be and it hereby is set for hearing on November 19, 1981, at 9:30 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Bracken County Water District No. 1 shall publish once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas in which it serves a notice setting forth the place, date, hour and the general purpose of the hearing, the format of the publication to be conspicuous, and one of said notices to be published not more than 21 days or less than seven days prior to the hearing as required by KRS 424.130.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Bracken County Water District No. 1 shall either (1) include the proposed rates in the newspaper publication, or (2) at least 20 days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates and the place, date and hour of hearing.





IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the mailing of a typewritten or printed notice shall not obviate the requirement of newspaper publication set forth in the second ordering paragraph.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the publication or the mailing of the proposed rates shall include the following language:

> The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Bracken County Water District No. 1. However, the Public Service Commission may, after evidentiary hearings, order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in an increase in rates for consumers other than those rates included in this notice.
