O R D E R

On December 11, 1981, the Public Service Commission received a letter from Shelby Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation which sought approval from the Public Service Commission to utilize Frankfort Meter and Electric Company, Frankfort, Kentucky, for testing of its meters.

The Public Service Commission having considered the request and being advised is of the opinion and finds that:

1. In accordance with 807 KAR 5:006E, Section 13, Paragraph 2, a utility may have all or part of its testing of meters performed by another utility or agency which has been approved by the Commission for this purpose.

2. The proposed testing arrangement is in the public interest and should be approved.

The Public Service Commission further finds that the approval of the proposed arrangement does not relieve the utility from the responsibility of insuring that all tests

of meters and measuring devices are performed in accordance with the requirements of the regulations of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Shelby Rural Electric Co-operative Corporation be and it is hereby granted approval to utilize the services of Frankfort Meter and Electric Company, Frankfort, Kentucky, for testing of its meters.
