PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

Pursuant to its Order dated December 22, 1981, the Commission held a pre-hearing conference in the above matter which was attended by representatives of the attached list of companies. After hearing the statements of representatives of both the cable television companies and the utilities, the Commission issues the following Pre-hearing Conference Order:

1. A schedule for the further consideration of the issues involved was proposed by the Kentucky Cable Television Association which suggested a postponement of an evidentiary hearing until after briefs and reply briefs were filed by the parties. This proposal was rejected by the Commission.

2. Parties which have pre-filed testimony may supplement that testimony by mailing copies thereof to the various parties shown in the attached list on or before 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 15, 1982.

3. Parties which have not pre-filed testimony may file direct, but not rebuttal, testimony by placing copies thereof in the mail to the parties shown on the attached list on or before 4:30 p.m. Friday, January 15, 1982.

4. The evidentiary hearing will be held as originally scheduled beginning on February 2, 1982.

5. The utilities will present their witnesses on February 2 and February 3, 1982, and the cable television companies will present their witnesses beginning on Thursday, February 4, 1982.

6. On February 2, 1982, the following companies will present their witnesses in the order shown with the hearing beginning at 9 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission in Frankfort:

2. General Telephone
3. South Central Bell

4. The following telephone companies:

7. On February 3, 1982, the following companies will present their witnesses in the order shown with the hearing beginning at 9 a.m. in the hearing room of the Commission in Frankfort:
