O R D E R

On April 21, 1982, Washington-Lewisburg Water District ("Washington-Lewisburg") filed its application with the Public Service Commission seeking approval of a purchased water adjustment clause and authority to adjust its rates in accordance with that clause. Washington-Lewisburg's supplier, Maysville Utility Commission, notified Washington-Lewisburg of an increase in the wholesale cost of water pursuant to City Ordinance No. 82-7, enacted on April 26, 1982.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) The purchased water adjustment clause sought by Washington-Lewisburg is in compliance with 807 KAR 5:067, Purchased Water Adjustment Clause, is in the best interest of the public, and should be approved.

(2) The Maysville Utility Commission increased the wholesale cost of water effective with charges billed on and after June 1, 1982.

(3) The financial exhibits filed by Washington-Lewisburg indicate that it cannot absorb the increased cost of wholesale water.

(4) The calculation for the purchased water adjustment made by Washington-Lewisburg in the amount of \$.35 per 1,000 gallons is correct, and the purchased water adjustment should be approved.

(5) The base rate for purchased water for the future application of the purchased water adjustment clause should be:

	Next 6,000 gal. 1.66 per 1,000 gal.

	Over 50,000 gal. .77 per 1,000 gal.

A surcharge of 25 percent will be added to the bills of customers outside the City of Maysville.

(6) The rates in Appendix A are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the purchased water adjustment clause filed by Washington-Lewisburg be and it hereby is approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the purchased water adjustment sought by Washington-Lewisburg and the rates in Appendix A be and they hereby are approved for service rendered on and after the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the purpose of future application of the purchased water adjustment clause of Washington-Lewisburg, the base rate for purchased water shall be:

A surcharge of 25 percent will be added to the bills of customers outside the City of Maysville.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this order, Washington-Lewisburg shall file its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates and the purchased water adjustment clause approved herein.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 7952-1 DATED JUNE 15, 1982

The following rates are prescribed for the customers of the Washington-Lewisburg Water District. All rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of the Commission prior to the date of this order.

RESIDENTIAL

<u>Gallage Block</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
First 3,000 gallons	\$ 9.05 Minimum
Next 27,000 gallons	1.85 per 1,000 gallons
Over 30,000 gallons	1.60 per 1,000 gallons

COMMERCIAL

<u>Gallage Block</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
First 40,000 gallons	\$75.00 Minimum
Over 40,000 gallons	1.60 per 1,000 gallons

RESALE

<u>Gallage Block</u>	<u>Monthly Rate</u>
First 63,000 gallons	\$74.05 Minimum
Over 63,000 gallons	1.18 per 1,000 gallons
