## ORDER

On August 6, 1982, the Lake Village Water Association, Inc. ("Lake Village Water"), by counsel, filed its Motion for Emergency Relief stating that its credit and operations will be materially impaired or damaged by failure to permit the proposed rates to become effective pending a hearing. In support of the Motion, Lake Village Water refers to the financial documents filed herein and states that it does not have sufficient cash flow under its existing rates to meet its financial obligations.

On August 26, 1982, Lake Village Water again filed a Motion for Emergency Relief reiterating that its credit and operations will be materially impaired by failure to permit the rates to become effective pending a hearing.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. Lake Village Water has not filed the exhibits required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9, including the financial information required by Section 6 of the regulation.
- 2. The financial data filed in support of the Motion does not indicate that Lake Village Water will be unable to

perform its normal operations or that its credit or operations will be materially impaired or damaged by the failure to permit the proposed rates to become effective September 1, 1982.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion for Emergency Relief of Lake Village Water be and it hereby is denied and this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
