O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED That Maryville Sewerage System, Inc. shall file an original and seven copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division, by October 25, 1982:

1. Articles of incorporation. If the applicant is a corporation, a certified copy of its articles of incorporation, and all amendments thereto, if any, shall be annexed to the application. If applicant's articles of incorporation and amendments thereto, if any, have already been filed with the commission in some prior proceeding, it will be sufficient if this fact is stated in the application and reference is made to the style and case number of the prior proceeding. (807 KAR 5:001. Rules of Procedure. Section 7.(3).)
2. An analysis of customers' bills in such detail that the revenues from the present and proposed rates can be readily determined. (807 KAR 5:001. Rules of Procedure. Section 9.(2)(b).)
3. A copy of a valid third-party beneficiary agreement guaranteeing the continued operation of the sewage treatment facilities or other evidence of financial integrity such as will insure the continuity of sewage service. (807 KAR 5:071. Sewage. Section 3.(1)(a).)
4. A copy of the latest tax returns (federal and state, if applicable) filed by the applicant. (807 KAR 5:071. Sewage. Section 3.(1)(i).)

5. A full and complete explanation of corporate or business relationships between the applicant and a parent or brother-sister corporation, subsidiary(ies), a development corporation(s), or any other party or business to afford the commission a full and complete understanding of the situation. (807 KAR 5:071. Sewage. Section 3.(1)(1).)
