O R D E R

On December 20, 1982, the Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued a Show Cause Order against Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., citing apparent violations of 807 KAR 5:006(23). Those apparent violations involved the failure to report serious accidents promptly to the Commission.

After reviewing the pertinent regulations, the Commission has determined that its present regulations do not require reports of accidents resulting from defects or causes on the customer's side of the meter although such information is important to the carrying out of the Commission's functions.


Therefore, based on the facts of this case and evaluation of the scope of the regulations, IT IS ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is dismissed.
