On June 15, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8762 wherein it granted South Woodford Water District ("South Woodford") an increase in rates.

In Appendix A to that Order, the rates for the first usage levels for the 1-inch and 2-inch meters were inadvertently shown as per 1,000 gallons. These rates should have been shown as minimum bill rates for which the user is entitled to usage of 10,000 and 20,000 gallons, respectively.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in Appendix A to this Order be and they hereby are approved for service rendered on and after June 15, 1983.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 8762 DATED July 6, 1983.

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by South Woodford Water District. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the date of this Order.

RATES:

5/8 X 3/4 Inch Meter

First	2,000 gallons	\$7.65 Minimum Bill
Next	2,000 gallons	2.25 per 1,000 gallons
Next	6,000 gallons	1.60 per 1,000 gallons
Next	90,000 gallons	1.40 per 1,000 gallons
Over	100,000 gallons	1.25 per 1,000 gallons

1 Inch Meter

First	10,000 gallons	\$21.75 Minimum Bill
Next	90,000 gallons	1.40 per 1,000 gallons
Over	100,000 gallons	1.25 per 1,000 gallons

2 Inch Meter

First	20,000 gallons	\$35.75 Minimum Bill
Next	80,000 gallons	1.40 per 1,000 gallons
Over	100,000 gallons	1.25 per 1,000 gallons
