IT IS ORDERED that South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") shall file an original and 15 copies of the following information with the Commission on or before 12 Noon November 30, 1983. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each Item tabbed. When a number of sheets is required for an Item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to insure that it is legible. Where information requested herein has been provided along with the original application, in the format requested

herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request. When applicable, the information requested herein should be provided for total company operations and Kentucky jurisdictional operations, separately. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case may be dismissed.

1. Identify for all CPE the portion of the monthly rate which is associated with the apparatus to be transferred to AT&T and the portion which is associated with the inside wire to be retained by South Central Bell.

2. Quantify the revenue that would result from a continuation of the change for the portion associated with inside wire to be retained by South Central Bell using test year billing units.
