ORDER

On July 29, 1983, Union Light, Heat and Power Company filed a time-of-day tariff in compliance with the Commission's Order of February 28, 1982, in Administrative Case 203, The Determinations With Respect To The Ratemaking Standards Identified In Section 111(d)(1)-(6) of The Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978. Although the tariff has been designed to mitigate the possible adverse billing impact on any particular industrial or commercial customer, the Commission realizes that there will likely be an interest by the customers in understanding and questioning the new tariff. Therefore the Commission finds that the effective date of the time-of-day tariff should be suspended and a hearing scheduled to allow full consideration of the tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the effective date of the time-of-day tariff filed on July 29, 1983, shall be and hereby is suspended for a period of five months from the proposed effective date of the tariff. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing on this tariff shall be and hereby is scheduled for September 13, 1983, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky.
