O R D E R


On August 23, 1983, Air Products and Chemicals, Inc., Armco Inc., Ashland Oil, Inc., Huntington Alloys, Inc., and Kentucky Electric Steel Company ("Industrial Intervenors"), by counsel, filed a Motion and supporting Memorandum requesting that the Commission reschedule the hearing scheduled September 14, 1983, at 10:00 a.m., or, in the alternative, that the Commission extend until September 9, 1983, the time in which testimony or comments may be filed.
