ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on December 20, 1983, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That Farmers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Farmers") shall at least 20 days prior to the date of hearing mail to each customer a typewritten or printed notice of the proposed rates and charges setting forth the place, date and hour of the hearing. Alternatively, Farmers shall publish once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the areas served by Farmers a notice setting forth the place, date and hour of hearing and the proposed rates and charges per customer class as set forth in the Application, one of said notices to be published not more than 21 days or less than 7 days prior to the hearing as required by KRS 424.130. Each notice or publication shall also contain the following language:



The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Farmers Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates in this notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the notice or publication shall also include a statement to the effect that Farmers shall not be required to appear at the hearing unless an appearance is requested by the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division, other interested parties, or by the Commission on its own motion.
