On October 4, 1984, the Commission entered its draft Order in the above-styled case pursuant to Docket No. 81-893 of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). The draft Order proposes certain procedures under which embedded customer premises equipment ("CPE") owned by each independent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") would be detariffed.


