ORDER

On October 13, 1980, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 7800 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On September 21, 1984, Mt. Olivet Natural Gas Company, Inc., ("Mt. Olivet") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective September 1, 1984, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Mt. Olivet's notice of September 21, 1984, set out certain revisions in rates which Mt. Olivet proposed to place into

effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$569 or 1.3 cents per Dth.

- with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for rates to become effective September 1, 1984. On August 8, 1984, in Case No. 7800-DD, Mt. Olivet requested permission to track Transmission's rates. By Order issued August 29, 1984, the Commission approved Mt. Olivet's filing effective September 1, 1984. Subsequent to Mt. Olivet placing these rates into effect, Transmission filed revised tariffs on September 18, 1984, to be effective September 1, 1984.
- (3) Due to the retroactive nature of Transmission's decrease Mt. Olivet should report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1984, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections to its customers.
- (4) Mt. Olivet's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 7800, dated October 13, 1980, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1984.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1984.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Mt. Olivet shall report to the Commission any excess

revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1984, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections to its customers.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Mt. Olivet shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
