ORDER

On September 7, 1984, the Commission entered its Order granting the U.S. 60 Water District ("U.S. 60") an increase of \$9,837 pursuant to its purchased water adjustment application filed on May 15, 1984.

The Commission received on September 24, 1984, a letter trom U.S. 60 requesting that its case be re-opened to allow for the inclusion of information that would more accurately reflect the expected operating conditions of U.S. 60. U.S. 60 contends that, contrary to the final Order, revenues resulting from emergency water sales which are not expected to recur should not be included in the Commission's determination of the adjusted operating revenues and other expenses.

FINDINGS AND ORDERS

The Commission, after consideration of the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that U.S. 60's motion should be treated as an application for rehearing of



the September 7, 1984, Order. The Commission further finds that U.S. 60's position has merit and the above-styled case should be re-opened.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that U.S. 60's application for rehearing be and it hereby is granted.
