NOTICE OF PURCHASED GAS ADJUSTMENT FILING OF AUXIER ROAD GAS COMPANY, INC.

CASE NO. 8768-J

### ORDER

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On September 16, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8768 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On August 13, 1984, Auxier Road Gas Company, Inc., ("Auxier") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") effective September 1, 1984, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Auxier's notice of August 13, 1984, set out certain revisions in rates which Auxier proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase in price from its supplier in the amount of \$7,529 or 11.9 cents per Mcf. (2) On August 8, 1984, Columbia notified Auxier of a wholesale increase in the cost of gas effective September 1, 1984.


(3) Auxier's notice of August 13, 1984, requested an effective date of September 1, 1984, for its proposed rates. Auxier's notice does not provide the 20-day notice as required by statute; therefore, the proposed rates should become effective on and after September 2, 1984.

(4) Auxier's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8768 dated September 16, 1983, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after September 2, 1984. This adjustment is subject to refund because Columbia's rates are subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after September 2, 1984, subject to refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Auxier shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
