ORDER

On December 1, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8839 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On July 10, 1984, Western Kentucky Gas Company ("Western") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Texas Gas Transmission Corporation ("Texas Gas"), effective August 1, 1984, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Western's notice of July 10, 1984, set out certain revisions in rates which Western proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase in gas cost from its supplier in the amount of \$2,249,545 or 5.63 cents per Mcf.

- (2) Texas Gas has filed an application for increased rates to become effective August 1, 1984, with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.
- (3) Western's wholesale cost of gas from local producers which tracks Texas Gas' rate will be increased effective August 1, 1984.
- (4) In accordance with its purchased gas adjustment clause, Western's notice of July 10, 1984, includes its semi-annual production gas adjustment applicable to local production contracts. This results in a decrease of 0.44 cents per Mcf.
- (5) Western's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8839, dated December 1, 1983, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after August 1, 1984, subject to refund. This adjustment is subject to refund because Texas Gas' increase is subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after August 1, 1984, subject to refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Western shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
