ORDER

On June 27, 1984, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed a motion for clarification alleging that the Commission's Order entered May 16, 1984, is unclear as to the intended effective date of new time-of-day rates. On July 11, 1984, Arco Metal Company, E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company, Ford Motor Company, Kosmos Cement Company, Inc., and Olin Corporation filed a memorandum in opposition to LG&E's motion for clarification.

Having considered the matter and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that all parties should have 7 days from the date of this Order to file supplemental memoranda or request oral argument. If neither supplemental memoranda or a request for oral argument is received, the motion will be decided upon the basis of the existing record.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that all parties shall have 7 days from the date of this Order to file supplemental memoranda or request oral argument on LG&E's motion.
