O R D E R

On July 25, 1984, Barbour Manor Utilities, Inc., ("Barbour Manor") filed a petition for rehearing on six issues addressed in the Commission's Order of July 5, 1984. Barbour Manor requested rehearing on the issues of sludge hauling expense, transportation expense, routine maintenance expense, maintenance of treatment plant equipment, amortization of plant acquisition adjustment, and interest expense. The petition for rehearing contained an itemization of specific points which Barbour Manor considered important in evaluating the reasonableness of the expenses which were disallowed. However, no additional evidence was presented which was not considered in the Commission's Order of July 5, 1984. Each item presented by Barbour Manor was contained in the record and given full consideration by the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the petition for rehearing of July 25, 1984, is hereby denied.
