O R D E R

On June 21, 1984, National Southwire Aluminum Company ("NSA"), by counsel, filed its Motion for an Order extending the time (to and including July 3, 1984) in which NSA may file its prepared testimony.

The Motion states, among other things, that responses to NSA's First Request for Information were originally due May 30, 1984, but, by agreement with counsel for Big Rivers, the date was extended to June 5, 1984, that copies of certain requested


documents were not received by NSA until June 14, 1984, and that copies of other documents identified during depositions have not been received. The Motion further states that because of the delay NSA cannot reasonably comply with the Commission's revised Procedural Order entered June 4, 1984, and file its prepared testimony by June 27, 1984.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that an extension to and including July 3, 1984, would allow only one working day for requests for information to NSA pursuant to the revised order of procedure established in the Commission's Order entered June 4, 1984, and that, accordingly, NSA should be granted an extension of time only to the close of business June 29, 1984, within which to file its testimony.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion be and it hereby is sustained to the extent that NSA be and it hereby is granted an extension to the close of business June 29, 1984, to file its testimony.
