On September 13, 1984, Cincinnati Bell Long Distance ("CBLD") filed a motion to accord its "Business Plan - Cincinnati Bell Subsidiary" ("Plan") confidential treatment, with such material not being placed in the public record. CBLD stated that the Plan contains proprietary trade secrets and business plans the disclosure of which would cause substantial competitive injury. The Plan had originally been filed on September 7, 1984, as Attachment 2 in response to staff requests made at the public hearing on August 27, 1984.

The Commission, on consideration of the motion and being advised, hereby ORDERS the motion of CBLD sustained and that confidential treatment be afforded the Plan.
