O R D E R

On July 14, 1983, the Commission received a letter from the accountant for Primrose Place Treatment Plant, Inc., ("Primrose") disclosing that Primrose intended to dissolve its corporate existence and that the utility operations had been sold to the City of Paducah, Kentucky ("Paducah"). On December 7, 1983, the Commission received a copy of a letter which was sent by Primrose to its customers notifying them that the sewer operations were to be sold to Paducah. The Commission also received a copy of an agreement for sale, dated March 16, 1983, wherein Primrose agreed to sell its assets to Paducah.

Based on the evidence of record and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that Paducah possesses the requisite expertise to own, operate, and maintain the Primrose sewage treatment system in an adequate, efficient and reasonable manner.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the transfer of the sewerage treatment system of Primrose to Paducah be and it hereby is approved.
