On November 20, 1984, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("CBT") filed a proposed tariff to establish regulations, rates and charges for measured rate coin service for use with customer-provided coin-operated telephones.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that an investigation will be necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that the investigation cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date of December 13, 1984.
