ORDER

On November 13, 1984, the Commission issued an Order requiring B&H Gas Company ("B&H") to cease billing the 58 cent surcharge immediately, to file with the Commission a statement of total gas surcharge revenues collected since January 1, 1984, and to file revised tariff sheets setting out rates that reflected the deletion of the surcharge. It has come to the attention of the Commission that B&H is delinquent in filing the statement of total gas surcharge revenues collected since January 1, 1984, as was ordered by the Commission. Any amount over \$15,320 shall be due and refundable to the customers of B&H during this heating season. B&H should file this report with the Commission within 30 days of the date of this Order.

The Order of November 13, 1984, included the following language:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days from the date of this Order B&H shall file its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates approved herein.

The Commission finds the tariffs currently on file are correct and

meet this ordering requirement for the specific reason that B&H never filed tariffs that reflected the inclusion of the surcharge in its rates.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that B&H shall file with the Commission a statement of total gas surcharge revenues collected since January 1, 1984, within 30 days from the date of this Order. Any amount over \$15,320 shall be due and refundable to the customers of B&H during this heating season.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the tariff sheets currently on file at the Commission for B&H are correct.
