O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") shall file an original and 8 copies of the following information with this Commission, with a copy to all parties of record, by September 8, 1985. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case may be dismissed.

1. A statement setting forth the services provided and expenses incurred by Citizens Energy Corporation ("Citizens") in administering the 1984-85 Emergency Fuel Assistance Program.

2. An analysis of the extent to which the Special Emergency Assistance Program provided a market for previously shut-in local production.

3. A statement regarding whether Columbia could have purchased the gas acquired by Citizens, as listed in Attachment 2 of the Interim Report to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky of the Columbia/Citizens Energy 1984-85 Emergency Fuel Assistance Program ("Report"), directly from the suppliers at the prices Citizens paid.

4. An estimate of the effect of the 1984-85 Special Emergency Assistance Program on rates to Columbia's customers.

5. Supporting computations showing the rate of interest used in determining accrued interest on Attachment 1 of the Report.
