O R D E R

On April 3, 1985, Honorable David C. Olson, counsel for Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company, filed a motion requesting that the Commission direct all parties filing pre-filed testimony to serve it upon all parties of record by some expedited process, e.g. Federal Express, so that all parties would have the testimony at least by Monday, April 22, 1985.

Mr. Olson states that since the public hearing is scheduled for April 24, 1985, and the testimony to be provided need only be filed on or before Friday, April 19, 1985, it is possible that not all interested parties would receive the pre-filed testimony in adequate time to prepare for the hearing.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the pre-filed testimony be served on all parties of record by overnight courier service.
