O R D E R

On January 29, 1985, the Commission received a joint notice from the McKinney Water District ("District") and Mr. Andy Peck advising that the District will assume control of Mr. Peck's water line and existing customers pursuant to Mr. Peck's request. The Commission previously investigated Mr. Peck's water line and declared said line to be a utility by Order entered January 10, 1985, in Case No. 9222, In Re: PSC v. Peck.

Based on the evidence of record and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that the District is ready, willing and able to acquire and operate Peck's water line.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the acquisition of Peck's water line by the District be and it hereby is approved.
