## ORDER

On June 28, 1985, a hearing was held in the Commission's offices, Frankfort, Kentucky, in reference to Elk Lake Shores Water Company ("Elk Lake") not meeting the minimum requirements of Commission regulations. Elk Lake testified that it would have to make certain improvements to its distribution system to satisfy Commission requirements and that it did not have financing for the required improvements.

In a letter dated July 8, 1985, Elk Lake described several record keeping changes that had been made to meet requirements of Commission regulations. Elk Lake also stated that its compliance with all the cited regulations could not be accomplished without additional revenues.

On July 17, 1985, the Commission staff notified Elk Lake to describe, in writing, how, when and where financing for needed improvements would become available. Elk Lake's response of August 7, 1985, did not establish a timetable for securement of requisite financing or for accomplishment of its water system improvements.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Elk Lake shall prepare and follow a plan for accomplishment of the work essential to its compliance with Commission regulations. This plan shall include each essential event including the securement of financing and the date scheduled for completion of each event. A copy of this plan shall be filed with and approved by the Commission within 60 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that bi-monthly progress reports shall be filed with the Commission by Elk Lake until the work essential to its compliance with Commission regulations is substantially complete. The first report shall be filed on or before March 1, 1986.
