SHOW CAUSE ORDER

On February 11 and 12, 1985, the Commission received numerous complaints from customers of Meades Branch Gas and Water ("Meades Branch") in regard to undesirable and potentially hazardous conditions in the Meades Branch area of Lawrence County, Kentucky. The Commission staff investigated this complaint and notified Meades Branch, in writing, of the need for improved construction, better maintenance and more attentive operation. (See Appendix A)

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that this case be and it hereby is set for hearing on December 18, 1985, at 1:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room No. 2, in the offices of the Commission in Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Meades Branch shall appear at the hearing and show cause, if any it can, as to why it should not be subject to the penalties prescribed in KRS 278.990 for failure to comply with the Commission's regulations.

HISTORY AND BRIEF

My January 30, 1985, memo* was followed on February 11 and 12, 1985, by hotline complaints* from residents on Meades Branch. These people do not want their names used--they fear gas and water service cutoffs by a Mr. Kay Pigmon, current operator of the system supplying them natural gas and/or water.

My memo* prompted the earliest possible inspection of the Meades Branch situation. This Report reflects some of the undesirable and potentially hazardous conditions found on my inspection trip. The illicit operation of an utility (KRS 278.010(e)(b) & (d)) is indicated.

INSPECTION/INVESTIGATION

Following the hotline complaints* I made call-backs on February 14, 1985. On these telephone calls* the complainants related their problems with their natural gas and/or fresh water services.

The existence of an organized utility operation was outlined during our telephone conversations.

On March 13 and 14, 1985, I visited Meades Branch, talked to some of the customers, inspected the visible natural gas and water plant facilities, tasted the water and took some photos (see attached Photo Pages 1-7).

Two of the customers gave me various copies of their paid receipts (see Exhibits A-1, 2 and 3 attached). It should be noted that a Mr. Kay Pigmon signed one, initialed others, but only wrote in "Meades Branch Gas" on most of the receipts. I was given Mr. Pigmon's telephone number and have been unsuccessful in my repeated efforts to reach him.

CONCLUSIONS

It has been determined that the telephone is listed in a Ms. Debra A. Pigmon's name, and the mailing address is Route 4, Box 185, Louisa, Kentucky 41230. It has also been determined that Mr. Pigmon personally collects for his gas and water service at a higher rate than the prior operator, Mr. Ed Miller, used to charge. Notwithstanding, the reported discriminatory, unequal service to preferred customers, the impression is that Mr. Pigmon is poorly managing a utility system(s) (i.e. natural gas and fresh water) much in need of improved construction, better maintenance and more attentive operation.

Finally, we can conclude that this/these systems present hazards to the health and safety of Meades Branch residents--customers and others.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Commission be made aware of this illicit utility operations(s) so that it can order Mr. Kay Pigmon to show cause, if any he can, as to why he should not be required to uprate his utility systems to acceptable safety and health standards according to Commission Law and the regulations thereto.

It is further recommended that the Commission staff Water Section become informed of and involved in the handling of this situation.

Finally, it is recommended that a copy of this Report be sent to Mr. Kay Pigmon, at the above mentioned mailing address, so that he might be advised of our concerns and pending enforcement action.












Water main crossing of drain (same drain shown on page -5-)






