ORDER

On September 20, 1985, Continental Telephone Company of Kentucky filed a proposed tariff with the Commission to eliminate extra exchange line mileage charges in those exchanges handled by the London Digital Island to encourage subscribers to migrate toward one-party service. The proposed tariff was to become effective for service rendered on and after October 18, 1985.

Additional support information was requested and received on October 8, 1985.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff revision and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff revision be and it hereby is suspended for five months on and after October 18, 1985.
