## ORDER

On March 1, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8678 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On October 23, 1985, Western Lewis-Rectorville Water and Gas District ("Western Lewis") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective September 1, 1985, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Western Lewis' notice of October 23, 1985, set out certain revisions in rates which Western Lewis proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase price from its supplier in the amount of \$30 or .05 cents per Mcf.

- (2) Transmission filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") an application for increased rates to be effective September 1, 1985, subject to refund.
- (3) Inasmuch as the filing of revised tariffs by Transmission was too late for Western Lewis to make a timely filing for an increase to be effective September 1, 1985, the effective date should be November 12, 1985, rather than September 1, 1985, as proposed.
- (4) Western Lewis' adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8678, dated March 1, 1983, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after November 12, 1985. These rates are subject to refund because Transmission's are subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after November 12, 1985, subject to refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Western Lewis shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein. Done at Frankfort, Kentucky, this 7th day of November, 1985.
