O R D E R

On December 23, 1986, Louisville Gas and Electric Company, Western Kentucky Gas Company, Texas Gas Transmission Company and Entrade Corporation filed a joint motion for a continuance of the hearing scheduled for January 7, 1987. The basis for the motion is that there is a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission proceeding in which they are participating.

After a review of the record, the Commission believes the motion should be denied. Because of the number of parties involved, the Commission's schedule and the desire to conclude this proceeding in a timely manner, it is in the best interest of all parties to hold the hearing as scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion is denied.
