O R D E R

On September 15, 1986, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("SCB") filed a petition for confidential treatment of certain information supplied in response to the Commission's June 20, 1986, Order. The petition was filed pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7. SCB states that public disclosure of the investment and expense data could result in competitive harm to the company.

The Commission FINDS that SCB has met the conditions set out in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7, and that the petition should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that SCB's petition for confidentiality filed on September 15, 1986, be and it hereby is sustained.
